Tories stand up for local residents on 3rd runway

The recent vote in the House of Commons once again demonstrates that only a Conservative government will stand in the way of a third runway being built at Heathrow airport. The Labour Government pulled out all stops to ensure enough of its MPs voted in favour of Heathrow expansion.

The Labour Government used its numbers to vote for expansion and have made it clear they will continue until the runway is built.

Labour seem intent on ignoring local opposition so long as they are in power.



The residents of Ealing should not be fooled by Cllr. Sharma MP's somersault and if they want construction of third runway stopped, they can be confident that a future Conservative government will support that cause.

£26m in NHS cuts due to Labour mismanagement

Ealing's health service faces cuts of £13m over the next two years as the Government plans to take money to subsidise failing NHS Trusts in other parts of London. This comes on top of £13m already taken from the Trust in '06.

The Strategic Health Authority (SHA) is to cut 1.3% from Ealing's PCT budget to help with NHS debts in other London areas.

The Labour Government through the SHA is effectively penalising Ealing for having an efficient and well-managed PCT and now residents will suffer drops in service levels as a result.



It is unlikely that this, along with the money borrowed from the Trust in '06 will be returned.
